With reference to the subject cited above, I am enclosing herewith the new guideline of implementation of Scholarship scheme issued by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India, vide letter No. 8-4/2019-SS, Dated 17-07-2019 fixing the timeline for the three scholarship schemes for the year 2019-20, I would like to request you to inform all educational Institutions of your districts, so that the poor students from minority communities avail the benefit of the scheme.

It may noted as mentioned in para 6(vi) Email IDs and mobile nos. of all institutes/College/Schools registered/stored in NSP have been deactivated. State/UT Nodal officers, as the case may be, will verify credentials of the institutes/ College/ Schools Nodal officers, as the case may be, will verify credentials of the institutes/College/Schools Nodal officer and reset his/her password through a well-defined procedure, wherein the institutes/College/Schools Nodal officer will fill up an online form on the Portal and get the printout authenticated in duplicate by his/her Head of Institutes/College/Schools and submit it to the State Nodal Office. On verification, State Nodal officer will activate the account of the Institutes/College/Schools on the portal using their login, credentials. State/UT Nodal officer will retain a copy of duly authenticated online form, received from the Institutes/College/Schools and returned the second copy to the Institutes/College/Schools of their respective records. It will be the responsibility of the Institutes/College/Schools to retain the copy received from State Nodal officer and produce it to the appropriate authority on demand.

Necessary instructions may kindly be issued to all institutions of all districts from your end. Your action in this regard is highly solicited.

Subject: State/UT/Community-wise Physical Allocation of Scholarships and Timeline Activities under the three Scholarship Schemes for minority communities for the year 2019-20- regarding.

Madam / Sir,

The Ministry of Minority Affairs implements three Scholarship Schemes viz. Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes for the Minorities as Central Sector Schemes with 100% Central funding. Under these Schemes, scholarships are awarded to the economically weaker and meritorious students from six centrally notified minority communities viz. Buddhist, Christian, Jain, Muslim, Sikh, and Zoroastrian (Parsis) pursuing studies in India in a Government or recognised private university/institute/ college/school.

2 The Central Government has decided to open the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) on 15th July, 2018 for the three Scholarship Schemes for 2019-20. Other timelines are as under:

a. Opening of Portal for submission of Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Mean based scholarship application	15 th July 2019
b. Last date for Pre-Matric scholarship application	15 th October 2019
c. Last date for making Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Mean based scholarship application	31 st October, 2019
d. Last date for first level verification for Pre-Matric scholarship application	31 st October, 2019
e. Last date for second level verification for Pre-Matric scholarship application	15 th November, 2019
f. Last date for first level verification for Post-Matric and Merit-Cum-Mean based scholarships application	15 th November, 2019
g. Last date for second level verification for Post-Matric and Merit-Cum-Mean based scholarship application	30 th November, 2019

3. It is, thus, incumbent upon this Ministry to initiate the process of inviting online applications through the State Government/UT Administrations for the aforesaid Schemes, as per existing guidelines. The States/UTs should publicise the Schemes through advertisements in leading newspapers and other popular means in their respective State/UT to enable the minority students to avail the maximum benefits of these scholarship schemes. A copy of draft Advertisement for their use, as approved by MoMA is at Annex-IV. At the National level, Ministry of Minority Affairs will be issuing an advertisement.

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4. The State-wise/Community-wise physical allocation (as per Census 2011) for Fresh Scholarship in respect of three Scholarship Schemes for the financial year 2019-20 shall be 30 lakh, 5 lakh and 60,000 scholarships respectively. The States/UT-wise and Community-wise physical distribution of scholarships for above schemes is placed at Annex- I, II & III. As far as renewal applications are concerned, there is no target for them and all valid renewal applications are eligible for scholarship.

5. During 2019-20, the online implementation of the Pre-matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means based Scholarship Schemes shall be done through the **National Scholarship Portal (NSP) of the Government of India**, under URL www.scholarships.gov.in. A Mobile App- **National Scholarships (NSP)** has also been prepared for the same for use by all applicants in the remote/hilly areas. A link to the site is also made available in the website of this Ministry i.e. www.minorityaffairs.gov.in. **Only Online applications under the Schemes will be accepted and no request for Offline applications will be entertained.** The detailed guidelines of the three Scholarship Schemes and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) with the timelines is available on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP) as well.

6. In view of above, all State Governments/UT Administrations are requested to take the following actions, in addition to the actions as requested vide D.O. letter No. 8-3/2019-SS dated 5.07.2019, from Secretary (Minority Affairs), a copy of which is annexed.

- (i) All the Schemes need to be announced by the concerned State Government/UT Administration well in time, through advertisements in the leading vernacular language newspapers and local dailies and by using other suitable publicity media well in time.
- (ii) The advertisement will enable the minority students to avail the maximum benefits of scholarship schemes.
- (iii) All renewal applicants/students (applicants who have got scholarship during 2017-18) may apply by giving their existing Application ID.
- (iv) All Universities/Institutes/colleges/schools located in your State/UT may be advised to register themselves and their courses details on the NSP at the earliest so that their students can apply and they can verify such applications on the portal within the aforesaid timelines.
- (v) All Institutes/Schools that do not have valid AISHE/DISE codes have been deregistered. A provision has been made for their re-registration after obtaining valid AISHE/DISE code. States/UTs need to be proactive in re-registering such Institutes/Schools.
- (vi) Email IDs and mobile numbers of all Institutes/Schools registered/stored in NSP have been deactivated. District/State/UT Nodal officers, as the case may be, will verify credentials of the Institute/School Nodal Officer and reset his/her password through a well-defined procedure, wherein, the Institute/School Nodal Officer will fill up an online form on the Portal and get the printout authenticated in duplicate by his/her Head of the Institute/School and submit it to the District/State Nodal officer. On verification, District/State Nodal officer will activate the account of the Institute/School on the Portal using their login credentials.

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District/State/UT Nodal officer will retain a copy of duly authenticated online form, received from the Institute/School and return the second copy to the Institute/School for their respective records. It will be the responsibility of the Institute/School to retain the copy received from District/State Nodal Officer and produce it to the appropriate authority on demand.

(vii) All the three Scholarship Schemes are individual beneficiary oriented scheme being implemented by the Ministry of Minority Affairs and the whole scholarship is disbursed to the beneficiary under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) mode. In this regard it is stated that as per the Gazette Notification, issued with respect to these Schemes, under Section-7 of Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) on 21.04.2017 (copy enclosed at Annex-V), it will be necessary for the eligible applicants to provide Aadhaar number while applying for Scholarship and in case, an individual does not possess Aadhaar one can provide the details of alternative identification documents, as stated in the Gazette Notification, detailed below:

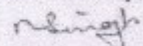
(a) if she or he has enrolled, her or his Aadhaar Enrolment ID slip; or a copy of her or his request made for Aadhaar enrolment, as specified in subparagraph (b) of paragraph 2; and

(b) Bank passbook with photograph; or (ii) Ration Card, or (iii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card issued by the Income Tax Department; or (iv) Passport; or (v) Certificate of identity having photo of such student issued by a Headmaster or Principal of School under official seal of the school; or (vi) Driving license issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or (vii) any other documents specified by the State Government or Union territory Administration. [Note: for Assam, Jammu & Kashmir and Meghalaya, the documents mentioned in para (b) shall only be required]

(viii) All efforts may be made to adhere to the aforesaid timelines and resolve any technical issue that may crop up in the process of online submission, generation of merit lists and payment lots by coordinating with the NIC HQ or State NICs at the earliest

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub:- Scheme fee waiver of admission fees tuition fees etc. for students taking Admission In H.S. / Degree and M.A./ M.Sc./M. Com Course.

In continuation of FEE WAIVER scheme under Pragyan Bharti for free admission in H.S. / Degree and M.A./ M.Sc./M. Com Course under Higher Education Department, the scheme will continue for the year 2021-22 for those whose parental income is below Rs. 2 lakh.

1. **Aim:** The aim of the scheme is access to the poor students of the State and to help them achieve the benefits of Higher Education.

2. **Scope and Applicability:** The Schemes will be applicable to the students seeking admission into 1st year of H.S./B.A./B.Sc./ B.Com and M.A./M.Sc/M.Com course. Students taking admission in any self-financing course are not eligible under this scheme. In case of H.S. and B.A./B.Sc./B.Com course, those students whose fees were waived earlier will also be eligible to avail the scheme for the second year and third year admission. For M.A./M.Sc./M. Com the benefit of the scheme is applicable for Final year for those whose fees were waived earlier.

3. **Institutes incorporated under the scheme:**

- i. All Provincialized and Govt. Colleges.
- ii. Gauhati University, Guwahati. / Dibrugarh University, Dibrugarh. / Bodoland University, Kokrajhar. / Cotton University, Guwahati. / Kumar Bhaskar Varma Sanskrit & Ancient studies University, Nalbari. / Women's University, Jorhat. / Bhattadev University, Bajali. / Rabindranath Tagore University, Hojai / Madhabdev University, Lakhimpur. / Majuli University of Culture, Majuli. / Sati Sadhini Raijyik Viswavidyalaya.

This scheme will not cover Private Colleges, Private Universities and Central Universities situated in Assam. The Scheme will be applicable to students pursuing higher education in colleges and Universities of Assam in the categories stated above.

4. **Applicability:**

Category of students eligible under the scheme:

- i. Students whose parental annual income is less than Rs. 2.00 lakh from all sources will be eligible to avail this scheme.
- ii. If either of the parent (mother or father) of the student is working in the State Govt./ Central Govt./Semi Govt./State or Central Govt. undertakings, such students shall not be eligible under this scheme.
- iii. Scheme is only for regular students having minimum 75% of attendance in classes with no back paper in previous examination.

5. **Proof of Income/Documents required:**

- i. An Income Certificate from the Local Revenue Circle Officer only.

- ii. A declaration from the students that neither of the parents (father or mother) of the students is an employee of State Central Govt. Department or its undertaking. Such form shall be devised by the concerned Registers/Principal. If such a declaration is found to be false, the admission shall be cancelled and fee shall be realized from such students.

6. **Power of Admission Committees:** The Admission Committees of the concerned Colleges and Universities shall have the power to enquire into the income of the family in case of doubt in regard to students and if the committee is of the view that the income of the parents exceed Rs. 2.00 lakh, the committee may recommended cancellation of admission notwithstanding documents submitted by the student. Such enquiry may commence suo moto by the institute or on a complaint received against any student availing benefit under this scheme. The Category of Institutes coming under the purview of the Scheme, shall constitute such committees comprising of Senior Teachers. The Principal/Registrar of the institution shall observe due diligence and will not allow any undeserving candidates. The Director of Higher Education will make random check of income certificate and disciplinary action may be taken against the student/ official or principal.

7. **Fee to be Waiver under the Scheme:**

Year	Category of Admission	Nature of Fees to be Waived
1 st Year/ New Admission	Higher Secondary, B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./ and M.A./M.Com./M.Sc. Session 2021-22	All Fees that a College or University realizes from students in Normal Course rate not to exceed than the fee realized last year i.e. 2020-21 session
2 nd year and 3 rd admission	For those admitted in B.A./B.Sc./B.Com with no fee during the session 2019- 20 and 2020-21.	Colleges will realize <u>only Magazine fees, Games & Sports fees and College Week Fees</u> . All other fees will be exempted. This benefit will accrue to those students who were admitted under this scheme during 2018-19, 2020-21 and 2021-22 session.
Final year admission	M.A./M.Sc./M.Com for those admitted with no fee during the session 2020-21	

8. **Duties and Responsibilities if Students availing the Scheme:**

Students seeking admission into 1st year will plant a sapling at his/her College or at his/her home and shall give photograph of the same to the college,. The student has to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission into second year shall give photograph of the same tree that was planted during previous year. A Scrutiny Committee shall be constituted comprising teachers which will examine the photographs and will assess the genuineness of the Photographs and growth of the plant. Only on receipt of recommendation from the Committee, the student can avail subsequent year fee waive. This will be effective from the session 2021 (applicable to those who benefited under the scheme during 2019-20 and 2020-21 session). Students availing the fee waiver benefit during the Current Year shall submit photograph of the sapling planted by them earlier to the College authority and the college authority shall scrutinize the authenticity of the same and allow the candidate accordingly.

9. **Responsibility of College and Universities:** All Colleges and University will be required to upload the names of students admitted availing fee waiver benefit, in the respective website.

10. **Marking at the reverse of Mark sheet of candidate given free admission:**

- The Colleges giving free admission under this scheme will give one endorsement at the reverse of relevant mark sheet of the student so that the student does not seek free admission in multiple Colleges.
- The Colleges and Universities will devise Rubber seal and use the seal at the reverse of mark sheets of the beneficiary students.

The Colleges and Universities will send the requirement for reimbursement of fund in prescribed pro forma together with name of students availing the benefit under the scheme within 45 days of admissions so that the Director can move Govt. for release of fund to institutes.

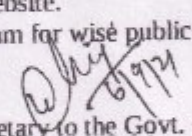

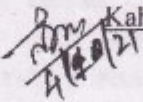

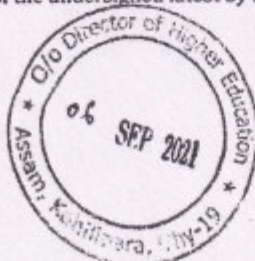

Madam/ Sir,

The Department of Higher Education has been implementing Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship (CSSS) for College and University Students since 2008-09. The Scheme has been approved by the Cabinet for continuation up to March, 2026 or till further review whichever is earlier, as component scheme under the Umbrella Scheme namely Pradhan Mantri Uchchatar Shiksha Protsahan Yojana (PM-USP) with some modifications in the existing Scheme. Accordingly, the revised Guidelines of the Scheme has been finalized and **copy is enclosed herewith**. Some of the salient features, including the application and verification process run through the National Scholarships Portal (<https://scholarships.gov.in>), inter-alia, are as under:

- i. Rate of scholarship is Rs.12,000/- per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20,000/-per annum at Post-Graduation level. However, students pursuing technical courses such as B.Tech, B.Engg. will get scholarship up to graduation level only i.e. Rs. 12,000/- p.a. for 1st, 2nd & 3rd years and Rs. 20,000/- in the 4th year;
 - ii. Students having gross parental/family income upto Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum are eligible for scholarship under the scheme. Income certificate will be required only for the fresh applicants;
 - iii. Online applications at National Scholarship Portal (NSP) will be verified at two levels, i.e. by the Institute, where the student is studying and thereafter by the concerned State Higher Education Department or any other Agency/ Official nominated by the State as State Nodal Agency (both for fresh and renewal applicants);
 - iv. Colleges and Universities will apprise the students about the "PM-USP CSSS" during admission. Aadhaar based authentication of Institute Nodal Officer (INO)/ State Nodal Officer (SNO) is mandatory for every Institution/State before verification of the applications. INO/SNO should be a regular employee and his/her Aadhaar authentication is mandatory;
 - v. Students who missed to apply for renewal of application online on NSP will be allowed to apply for renewal of scholarship for subsequent year on NSP, if he/she fulfills eligibility condition for renewal;
 - vi. Students will not be permanently debarred for scholarships due to delay in renewal or verification. However, students will have to submit renewal applications within a cut-off date. Renewal for that year will not be allowed, if an applicant misses this deadline;
 - vii. Adequate publicity of the scheme may be initiated through the Schools/ Colleges/ Institutions/ Universities to create awareness and to facilitate/ assist the applicants in rural areas to apply for scholarship online on NSP.

2. It is requested to issue necessary instructions as per the revised guidelines of the Scheme on priority basis, particularly:

- appoint State Nodal Officer from your Department or nominate any other Agency/ Official as State Nodal Agency (both for fresh and renewal applicants) before opening of the National Scholarship Portal (NSP), which usually opens in the month of July- August every year. The details of the State Nodal Officer may please be intimated to this Ministry.
- give wide publicity to the revised guidelines of CSSS for College and University Students through local newspapers/ pamphlets or electronic media so that maximum eligible students can avail the benefits of the Scheme.

PRADHAN MANTRI UCHCHATAR SHIKSHA PROTSAHAN (PM-USP) YOJANA

**GUIDELINES FOR THE COMPONENT SCHEME –
CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIP FOR COLLEGE AND
UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (PM-USP CSSS)**

(Applicable for academic year 2022-23 onwards)

1. Objective

To provide financial assistance to meritorious students from poor families to meet a part of their day-to-day expenses while pursuing higher studies.

2. Scope

The scholarships are awarded by Ministry of Education, Government of India on the basis of results of Higher Secondary / Class XII Board Examination. A maximum of 82,000 fresh scholarships per annum are provided for pursuing graduate / postgraduate degree in colleges and universities and for professional courses, such as Medical, Engineering etc.

3. Allocation of Scholarship

The total number of scholarships are divided amongst the State Education Boards based on the State's population in the age group of 18-25 years, after segregating share of CBSE and ICSE on the basis of number of students passing out from various Boards in the country. 50% of the scholarships are earmarked for girls. Out of the total scholarship slots earmarked for UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, 3% slots shall be earmarked for the students from the UT of Ladakh. The number of scholarships allotted to a State Education Board is distributed amongst pass outs of the Humanities, Science and Commerce streams in the ratio of 3:3:1. In case of shortfall in the number of applications, the scholarship slots shall be interoperable among categories (Gen, OBC, SC & ST), gender (Female, Male) and State Quota to maximize use of slots for fresh scholarships with effect from academic year 2022-23, subject to the condition that guidelines of Ministry of Finance and NITI Aayog regarding SC/ST fund allocation of the schemes are adhered to.

4. Eligibility for Scholarship

- i. Students who are above 80th percentile of successful candidates in the relevant stream from the respective Board of Examination in Class XII of 10+2 pattern or equivalent;

- ii. Pursuing regular degree courses and not correspondence or distance mode or pursuing Diploma courses;
- iii. Pursuing courses at colleges/institutions recognized by All India Council for Technical Education and respective Regulatory Bodies concerned;
- iv. Not availing benefit of any other scholarship schemes including State run scholarship schemes/ fee waiver & reimbursement scheme;
- v. Students with gross parental/family income upto **Rs. 4.5 lakh per annum** are eligible for scholarship under the scheme. Income certificate will be required only for the fresh applicants;
- vi. Student changing his/ her college/institute of study will be allowed to continue/renew the scholarship provided the course of study and the institution is having valid AISHE Code; The AISHE code can be checked in the portal <https://aishe.gov.in/aishe/aisheCode>
- vii. Students who missed to apply for renewal of application online on NSP will be allowed to apply for renewal of scholarship for subsequent year on NSP, if he/she fulfils eligibility condition for renewal;
- viii. For renewal of scholarship in each year of study, besides getting at least 50% marks in the Annual Examination, maintenance of adequate attendance of at least 75%, will also be the criteria. Complaints against the student regarding any in disciplined or criminal behaviour including any complaints of having indulged in ragging, will lead to forfeiture of scholarship;
- ix. Beneficiaries/ Applicants under the scheme must apply online in the National Scholarships Portal (www.scholarships.gov.in) for the fresh/ renewal scholarships. Fresh/Renewal applications sent directly to the Ministry of Education shall not be accepted.

5. Reservation

Students belonging to reserved categories/weaker sections /minorities etc. are eligible to get benefit of reservation on the basis of merit, subject to Central Reservation Policy [i.e. 15% seats are earmarked for SCs, 7.5% for STs and 27 % for OBCs and 5% horizontal reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in all the categories]. The Central Reservation Policy will be applicable in filling the slots against each year's target. If slots under a specific group is not filled after considering all the States/UTs, the vacant slots will be allocated to other categories so that maximum number of eligible students can get the benefit, subject to overall ceiling of slots.

The student can track their payment status from the template "Know Your Payment" in the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) portal [<https://pfms.nic.in/Users/LoginDetails/Login.aspx>] either by indicating Aadhaar number or bank account number or NSP Application ID.

9. For Colleges/Universities

College and Universities will apprise the students about the "PM-USP CSSS" during admission. Aadhaar based authentication of Institute Nodal Officer (INO)/ State Nodal Officer (SNO) is mandatory for every Institution/State before verification of the applications. INO/SNO should be a regular employee.

10. For State Government/State Boards

Adequate publicity of the scheme may be initiated through the Schools/ Colleges/ Institutions to create awareness and to facilitate/ assist the applicants in rural area to apply for scholarship online on NSP.

7. Rate and Duration of Scholarship (from financial year 2022-23)

The rate of scholarship is Rs.12,000/-per annum at Graduation level for first three years of College and University courses and Rs.20,000/-per annum at Post-Graduation level. Students pursuing professional courses, in case, where the duration of course is five (5) years/integrated course will get Rs. 20,000/-per annum in the 4th and 5th year. However, students pursuing technical courses such as B.Tech, B.Engg. will get scholarship up to graduation level only i.e. Rs. 12,000 p.a. for 1st, 2nd and 3rd year and Rs. 20,000 in the 4th year.

Note: The rate of scholarship is Rs.10,000/-per annum for first three years of fresh/renewal scholarships with respect to academic year 2021-22, even if the actual release happens in FY 2022-23.

8. Payment of Scholarship

Students are required to have the bank accounts opened, especially, in their name for availing the benefits under the scheme. The scholarship will be disbursed directly into the savings bank accounts of the beneficiaries through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT)
