A BRIEF PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

With a cultural heritage that goes back to more than 30 years, Chhamaria Anchalik College, only the nest of higher education for never ending generations to come at Chhamaria and its adjoining areas of Kamrup district in Assam(India), earns authentic confidence to call ascending pursuit in higher education. The college was established on the 12th August 1994 by some intellectual pioneers of the time.

The first meeting for the college was held on the 24th January, 1982 at public information organized by the Chhamaria Yubak Sangha to arrange a committee for the proposed Chhamaria Anchalik College was formed in 1981. The meeting was held at the premises of Chhamaria Yubak Sangha, a harbinger of social and cultural organization of Chhamaria Satra village. Sri Harendra Narrayan Mazumdar was the president and Sri Khagen Bayan was the secretary of the preparation committee.

The first class started in the B.A. for First year in Arts stream. In its initial period, classes were held in the Chhamaria High School in the early morning. In the year 1997 the college activities were shifted to its own building. The first Principal of the college was Late Gajendra Thakuria.

The College is now permanently affiliated to Gauhati University and under 2(f) and 12(B) of the University Grant Commission. At the outset of the college, seven departments were introduced and the two departments – Arabic and Philosophy were introduced later on. All the departments excluding English have Major Courses.

The present day college is compatible with building construction for infrastructural development. The college is being led under Governing Body and additionally charged by College Development Committee.

COLLEGE INFRASTRUCTURE:

The college has been playing a pivotal role since its inception in 1994, a long walk of 30 years, doing development adequate infrastructural facilities. At present two nos. of new buildings have been completed sponsored by the Govt. of Assam under “Infrastructure Development of Colleges” scheme.

The University Grant Commission has blessed the college with 16 computers, two Xerox machines, and one smart class room. The books are available in the library and a big size LCD TV serving all-round development to student community. More over there is a digital room, ICT Class Rooms which are ready to serve on the year.
